




Land north of Oak Road, West Hill

About the site

The site measures just under 5 acres (approximately 2 hectares) and is situated to the south of West Hill, adjoining the existing built-up area of the village. It comprises arable grassland and is well contained, surrounded by hedges and trees which make it unobtrusive in the landscape.

It is outside any landscape, ecological or heritage designations. The site's location is sustainable as the village centre and its facilities and amenities are at a walkable and cycling distance. The site is within Flood Zone 1, which has the lowest probability of flooding. A flood risk assessment has been undertaken and Morrish Homes' drainage engineers confirm that foul and surface water drainage from any housing development could be discharged acceptably by the time an application can be submitted to the local authority.



Local Policy: East Devon District's need for housing

The district of East Devon has a pressing need for new homes and East Devon District Council is currently reviewing the Local Plan to ensure that the homes that need to be built for local people are being delivered. The emerging Local Plan is progressing through the development plan process, with a Call for Sites issued early this year and with the aim to adopt the new Local Plan in 2023. At present, East Devon district needs to deliver around 1,000 new homes per annum to meet Government requirements. Morrish Homes' plans for land north of Oak Road would contribute circa 23 new homes towards this target.

Adequate parking for residents and visitors



Biodiversity net gain opportunities through planting and sustainable drainage
